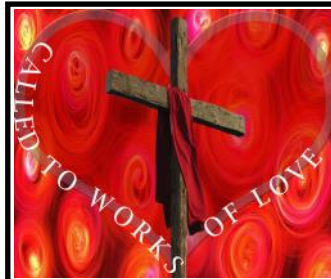

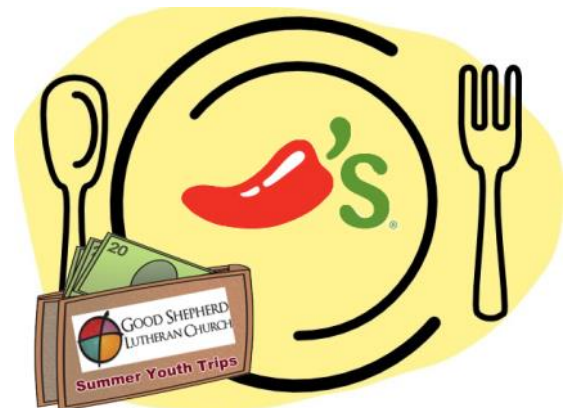
*Happy Birthday!*
