WELCOME PASTOR DAVE OSBORNE

Pastor Osborne is a 1973 graduate of Texas Christian University, Fort Worth, Texas, with a BA in Sociology/Psychology. In the fall of 1973 he entered Concordia Theological Seminary, Saint Louis, Missouri, and graduated from Concordia Seminary-in-Exile in the spring of 1977 with his Masters of Divinity degree, and was ordained three months later. He served Zion Lutheran Church, Wausau, Wisconsin (Assistant Pastor 1977-1981), Trinity Lutheran Church, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania (Pastor 1981-1987), Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Woodstock, Georgia (Founding and First Pastor, 1987-2002), Christ Lutheran Church, Hilton Head Island, South Carolina (Pastor 2005-2015). In 2002-2005 Pastor Osborne served as Assistant to the Bishop, Pastor for Transforming Congregations for the Southeastern Synod ELCA. Before fully retiring he served as the Interim Senior Pastor, Lutheran Church of the Redeemer, Atlanta, Georgia 2015-2017. He is married to Karen Schoenberger Osborne. They have one daughter, Courtney, who lives in Decatur, Georgia and is married with two daughters, and a son, Jeremy, who lives in Austin, Texas. Pastor Osborne and his wife currently live in Woodstock.

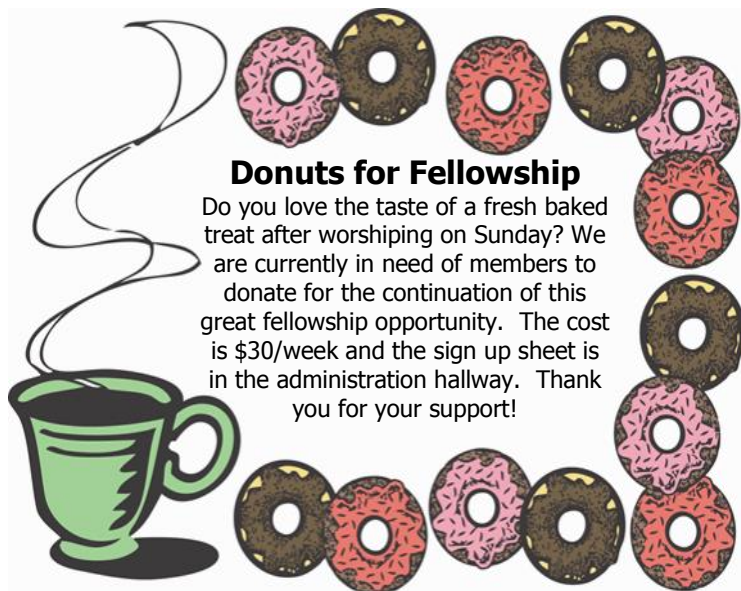
- Toothbrushes
