### What we will be doing in Nashville:

#### Ministry Partners in Nashville (service time):

- **Soles 4 Souls** If you want to learn about a world-wide mission, S4S will surely grab your attention. S4S is a social enterprise, non-profit organization that creates sustainable jobs and provides relief by distributing shoes and clothing around the world. Youth will have an opportunity to learn more about the mission and work in the warehouse for an afternoon.
- **Second Harvest Food Bank** is a central distribution center which collects food that would otherwise be wasted. Second Harvest distributes food to more than 490 agencies in Tennessee who are feeding the hungry. Volunteers at the Second Harvest warehouse will sort and pack grocery donations before they are distributed to partner agencies.
- **Nashville Food Project** embraces a vision of vibrant community food security in which everyone in Nashville has access to the food they want and need through a just and sustainable food system. The youth will work in their various gardens and prepare food to serve their clients.
- **Buena Vista Elementary** One way Serve Boldly partners with the local community is through the local schools. Last summer we served at a few different schools providing basic maintenance that may otherwise have been neglected or postponed. This opportunity was an ideal chance to invest in community through basic sweat equity.
- **St. Paul's Lutheran Church** Any team traveling to Nashville would be amiss not to join Pastor John and St. Paul's as they serve one of the most challenged neighborhoods in the city with persistence, passion, and humility.

#### Free Time Activities:

- **Broadway** - A classic Nashville attraction, we will walk from our housing site to Broadway Street, where we will split into groups for dinner out and walk up and down the street, exploring the many gift shops and novelty stores.
- **Bicentennial Park** - This park has lots of space to run around, throw a frisbee, splash in the water fountains, and perhaps even get the chance to listen to some live music!
- **J Percy Priest Lake** - J Percy Priest Lake is 42 miles long, 14,000 acres, and just a short drive from Downtown Nashville. We will spend one evening out on the lake for some swimming and supper. It's a great way to enjoy the night after a hard day of work and service.
