<p>In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. And he came to her and said, "Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Do not regard your servant as a worthless woman, for I have been speaking out of my great anxiety and vexation all this time." <p>And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great... [vs 31-32a]</p>	<p>I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep to be prince over my people Israel; and I have been with you wherever you went, and have cut off all your enemies from before you; and I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. [vs 8b-9]</p>
<p>...and will be called the Son of the Most High,... [vs 32b] ...he will be called Son of God. [vs 35b]</p>	<p>I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. [vs 14a]</p>
<p>...and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. [vs 32c]  <i>Jesus was about thirty years old when he began his work. He was the son (as was thought) of Joseph son of Heli...son of Nathan, son of David...son of Abraham...son of Adam, son of God. [Luke 3:23-38]</i></p>	<p>Moreover the Lord declares to you that the Lord will make you a house. When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come forth from your body, and I will establish his kingdom forever. **High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be called Son of God. And now your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. For nothing will be impossible for God.” [vs 34-37]**

They said to him, “Where is your wife Sarah?” And he said, “There, in the tent.”

Then one said, “I will surely return to you in due season, and your wife Sarah shall have a son.” And Sarah was listening at the tent entrance behind him. Now Abraham and Sarah were old, advanced in age; it had ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women.
