

Disappointed that we can't have our beautiful and traditional Christmas Eve services? Feeling like the Grinch because we can't sing our favorite carols together? Join us for our first ever drive-in worship services. Come in your car to a 2, 7 or 9 pm service where parking attendants will meet and direct you.





You might even decorate your car to add to the fun. There will be live worship leaders and the service will be transmitted through your FM car radio. You can sing away inside your car. Rather than candle lighting, you should bring flashlights or phones or glow sticks, or any source of light. (In the event of rain, all services will be cancelled.)

We have worship servant roles for these services. Consider signing up to be an Assisting Minister, Lay Reader or Parking Attendant. Sign-up at Sign Up Central Online here.

On Christmas Eve, all traffic will need to ENTER and EXIT through the <u>Eagle Drive</u> (Towne Lake) entrance. The Rose Creek Drive WILL BE CLOSED, to accommodate traffic flow and parking for the service.
