April 5: Sighs Too Deep for Words: Intercessory Prayer



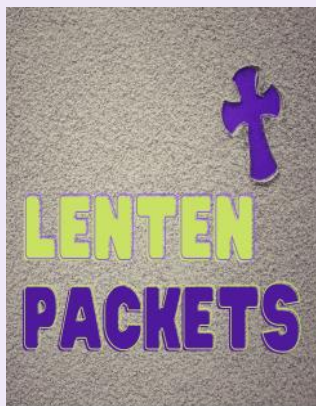
