

In honor of the 250th anniversary of the writing of "Amazing Grace," this worship series for Lent, by theologian Michael Hoy, ties the words of the beloved song to our lives today as Christ's disciples. Those in the Bible who experienced the amazing grace of God help us each week to realize that though we once were lost in sin, we now have been found by Jesus, and though we once were blind to



God's mercy, we now can see his love at work in us, through our Savior's death and resurrection.
