

anniversary of the writing of
"Amazing Grace," this worship
series for Lent, by theologian
Michael Hoy, ties the words of
the beloved song to our lives
today as Christ's disciples.

experienced the amazing grace
of God help us each week to
realize that though we once
were lost in sin, we now have
been found by Jesus, and
though we once were blind to



God's mercy, we now can see his love at work in us, through our Savior's death and resurrection.

We will be offering services each Wednesday throughout Lent, at 11 AM and 7:30 PM, with soup and salad offered before each evening service beginning at 6:30 PM.

This week (March 22) **The Blind Man** (John 9:24): We witness Jesus bringing sight to a man born blind, giving the man the added spiritual vision to see the amazing grace of God found in Jesus, who heals us all.
