This week's Favorite hymn or song is, "I Love to Tell the Story", was selected by Tracey Homer. "I remember singing it with my Grandma Lou when I was little."

This is truly a hymn loved by all. It has been published in over 1,200 hymnals. The lyrics come from a poem penned by Katherine Hankey in 1866. Katherine was an English evangelist. She became gravely ill while on a mission trip in Africa. As she was recovering, she wrote a 52 stanza poem in 2 parts "The Story Wanted" and later "The Story Told". William G. Fischer, a music professor at Girard College in Pennsylvania, selected some of the stanzas from part one and the refrain from part two. He set them to music and published the hymn in 1869.
