This week's Favorite hymn or song, "Onward Christian Soldiers", was selected by Sharron Ryan "As a little girl, I remember always singing it."

The text for this hymn was dashed off in about 15 minutes by Sabine Baring-Gould in 1865. It was used as a processional hymn for children in Horbury Bridge where Baring-Gould was serving as a curate. It was originally sung to the melody of the slow movement from Hayden's Symphony in D, No.15. Later, in 1872, Arthur S. Sullivan wrote the tune St. Gertrude for this hymn. This is the tune we all love to sing today.

"The hymn's theme is taken from references to the Christian being a soldier for Christ, for example 2 Timothy 2:3. Since the 1980's, the hymn has been a point of controversy due to its militaristic imagery, but yet we still today cling to the image of a church of frail saints who believe that we can defeat our foes. "

Special note of trivia, Arthur S. Sullivan is the same Sullivan of Gilbert and Sullivan fame. His musical works include 'H. M. S. Pinafore' and 'The Pirates of Penzance.'
