This week's Favorite hymn or song, "Here I Am, Lord", was selected by 2 different people. Barb Kidder "It is a powerful reminder that we are the instruments God used to do his work," and Ruth Clark "This is what I want to be remembered for. Hope it is played at my funeral."

The words and music for this song were first published in 1981 by Daniel L. Schutte. "Here I Am, Lord" is a popular song that has been published in over 63 separate hymnals and songbooks and has multiple arrangements for choirs and instrumentals. Schutte was raised in Wisconsin and was one of the founding members of the St. Louis Jesuits. He later left the society in 1986. He continues to write and perform liturgical music and is currently "Composer-in-Residence" at the University of San Francisco.
