"How Great Thou Art" is based on the 1885 Swedish poem "O Store Gud" by Carl Boberg. It was later set to a Swedish folk tune in the 1880's. The version we use today is an English translation and adaptation of the old Swedish folk tune by Stuart K. Hine, and published in 1953. The song was soon popularized in the late 1950's by George Beverly Shea, who often sang it for the Billy Graham Crusades.
