This week’s favorite hymn or song is “How Great Thou Art”, selected by Donna Garges. “This is a song sung at every family funeral I’ve attended. It’s always a reminder that God’s bigger and greater, even in death. My family can certainly belt this one out!”

Great selection Donna! This is truly an intergenerational hymn and song, remaining in the top 100 songs for CCLI which sources Praise Music.

“How Great Thou Art” is based on the 1885 Swedish poem “O Store Gud” by Carl Boberg. It was later set to a Swedish folk tune in the 1880’s. The version we use today is an English translation and adaptation of the old Swedish folk tune by Stuart K. Hine, and published in 1953. The song was soon popularized in the late 1950’s by George Beverly Shea, who often sang it for the Billy Graham Crusades.
