It was devised by Eric Milner-White, the newly appointed Dean of King's, who was 34 and a former WWI army chaplain. Milner-White wanted a more imaginative and devotional form of worship, especially after the war's trauma. Instead of a complicated mass, the carols service was simpler, alternating between choral anthems, congregational hymns, and readings. The resulting service was more accessible and meaningful, and acknowledged the suffering of those impacted by the Great War. He adapted a model from the Bishop Edward White Benson, who had devised an earlier lessons-and-carols form for Truro Cathedral in 1880.

Ithough the readings, prayers, and music change from year to year, the service from King's College has been broadcast annually by the BBC since 1928 and broadcast worldwide since 1954.


