The Outreach Committee is happy to announce a new opportunity to share the gifts God has given us. **Sleep in Heavenly Peace** is a national ministry that provides beds for children who do not have their own bed. Currently, there are over 8,000 children in Cherokee county that do not have their own beds to sleep in. There are several ways to help. The first is to help build the beds. The first build is on Saturday, March 7. To register to help go to shpbeds.org. If you know of a child that is in need of a bed, register them at this link as well.

Ron Mixon, a member of Good Shepherd will be leading a group on March 7th at Lowes, in Canton, to build as many beds as possible from 9-1. All wood and tools will be provided.

The second way to help is to **provide new twin bedding for the beds**. Our Outreach Committee will collect new twin mattresses, pillows, sheets and blankets. A spot will be designated in the Fellowship Hall for donations. Due to limited space, A Bed in a Bag and mattresses in a box are preferred, but all new bedding is acceptable.

(Twin mattress size is 6" deep x 38" wide x 75" long.)
