Summer Bible Studies

It's Summer! Does that mean we stop learning? Of course not! Please join us this summer as we come together in community to think about and discuss God's call for us to live out our faith in the real world – that world right outside of our doors. We'll discuss the ELCA Social Statements, how they begin in congregations just like Good Shepherd, then are developed by the wider church to guide God's work in the world.

Sundays, June 14 and 21 at 9:45 AM– Pastor Karen and Deborah Ezell will kick off the discussions by sharing the purpose and development of an ELCA Social

Statement. Our first statement to consider will be Church in Society. What is the church's relation to society, its public presence and responsibilities?

Later in mid July we will learn more about "Peace" and in September we will cover the social statement concerning "Civic Life".
